### Arthritis: The Nation's Leading Cause of Disability

**\$81 billion** was the direct medical cost associated with arthritis in 2003.1

**38%** of the 42.7 million adults with doctor-diagnosed arthritis report limitations in their usual activities due to their arthritis.2

**67 million** adults are projected to have doctor-diagnosed arthritis by 2030. Two thirds of those with arthritis will be women.1

An 11 lb. weight loss reduces the risk of developing osteoarthritis of the knee by 50% among women.3

3 x weekly

moderate physical activity can reduce arthritis-related disability by 47% in adults with knee arthritis.4

**44 million** outpatient visits and almost 750,000 hospitalizations result from arthritis.5

**418,000** total knee replacements were performed in 2003 primarily because of arthritis.6

**50%** of adults 65+ reported having arthritis in 2003 to 2005.1

1 in 5 adults in the United States report having doctor-diagnosed arthritis.1

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
